I understand that neither the Clay Station Horse Park or Starkey Family Trust and its officers, officials or organizing committee nor the property owners accept any responsibility for accidents, damage, injury or illness to the horses, owners, riders, drivers, grooms, passengers, attendants, spectators or any other persons or property in connection with this clinic/show/lessons. I hereby expressly agree for myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents: 1) to be bound by the rules of the Clay Station Horse Park and local rules of this clinic/show/lessons; 2) that every horse, driver, attendant, groom and/or passenger and spectator is eligible as entered; and 3) and to accept as final any decision of the clinic/show officials on any question arising under the clinic/show rules and any local rules of the clinic/show and agree to hold Clay Station Horse Park and Starkey Family Trust harmless for any action taken.
